

AMENDMENT NO. 18-1
TO THE
RULES AND REGULATIONS PROVIDING BENEFITS
OF THE
MEBA VACATION PLAN

At their June 20, 2018 meeting, the Trustees of the MEBA Vacation Plan (the "Plan") approved the following changes to the Plan's Rules and Regulations regarding uncashed checks and payments due to missing Participants or survivors, effective January 1, 2018.


1. The Plan shall be amended to add a new Section 19 to read as follows:

18. UNDELIVERABLE BENEFITS

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, if a check is issued for Benefits described hereunder, and the Plan, after making a reasonable effort, is unable to locate the Participant or survivor as described in Section 14 (or the Participant or survivor is located but fails or refuses to cash the check), the Benefits of such Participant or survivor shall be forfeited as of the end of the Plan Year that includes the twelfth month after the date such check was issued.

A record of the uncashed check amount shall be maintained and if such Participant or survivor subsequently makes proper claim for such amounts, the amount of such check shall be restored and shall be distributed to such Participant or survivor, but without any interest or earnings.
