

AMENDMENT NO. 22-5
TO THE
RULES AND REGULATIONS
OF THE
MEBA MEDICAL AND BENEFITS PLAN

At their February 10, 2022 meeting, the Trustees of the MEBA Medical and Benefits Plan (the “Plan”) amended the Plan’s Rules and Regulations to increase the annual maximum benefit for Applied Behavioral Analysis therapy related to the treatment of Autism Spectrum Disorders, effective January 1, 2022.

1. Article VI, Section 3(e) shall be amended by replacing paragraph (36) in its entirety with the following:

- (36) coverage of behavioral health treatments such as professional, counseling, guidance services and treatment programs, including Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) when provided by a board-certified behavior analyst licensed by the applicable state board of medicine. The ABA services are subject to an annual maximum of \$50,000 and are for Dependent children under age 7 necessary to develop, maintain, or restore the functioning of the Dependent child.
